

# 2024 – 2025 ANNUAL EVALUATION REPORT



This year, the ALL Stars program supported 20 student-athletes and awarded \$73,000 in scholarship funds. At the conclusion of the program, we conducted an anonymous survey to gauge programmatic impact and success. Of the 20 students, we received 17 completed surveys.

## Survey results show we are achieving the program’s objectives.

## Students worked together to complete 5 capstone projects.

- Facilitated a workshop for students at Albert Hill Middle School to share the benefits of active living and participating in sports.
- Created a series of Brain Break videos to encourage movement during the school day for elementary school students.
- Built garden beds at Ratcliffe Elementary School.
- Created a Bike Safety Escape Room website, featuring bike safety videos and content, geared towards elementary school students.
- Refurbished and painted the blacktop at Harry E. James Elementary School.
