

Mission Impossible

<u>Materials Needed</u>: Blind fold (1 per team), Cones, Obstacles (ex: bean bags, balls, cones, bowling pins, etc.)

Set Up:

- 1. Using the cones, create a relay line for each team. Place 1 cone at each of the relay lanes.
- 2. Scatter your obstacles within the relay lines. Leave enough space between obstacles for kids to move safely.
- 3. Divide students into pairs (or teams for larger groups). Provide each pair/team a blindfold.

How To Play:

- 1. Pairs/teams will work together to move across the activity area to the opposite cone and back without touching any obstacles.
- 2. Assign the first 'agent'. This is who will wear the blindfold. The other team members are 'scouts'.
- 3. The 'scouts' will use verbal cues to guide their partner through the obstacle course. NO TOUCHING!
- 4. Once the first 'agent' makes it to the opposite cone, quickly switch roles and go back to the first cone.
- 5. If the 'agent' touches an obstacle, both players must return to the original cone, switch roles, and try again.
